Where is London?


London is a capital city.

Around 8 million people live in London!





I arrived in London by train to London St. Pancras Station. This is one of the biggest railway stations.






How Did Ted Get There?





I then bought a ticket for the **London Underground** or the 'tube'. This is a very fast train which travels underground and helps you get around London in a quick and easy way!








London's Landmarks












London 2012!


