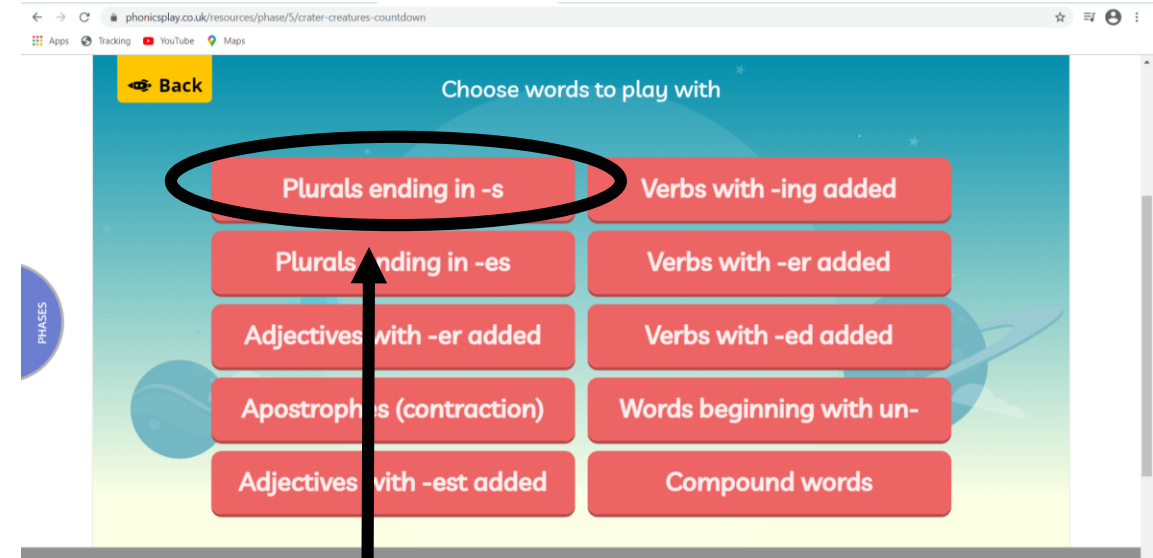
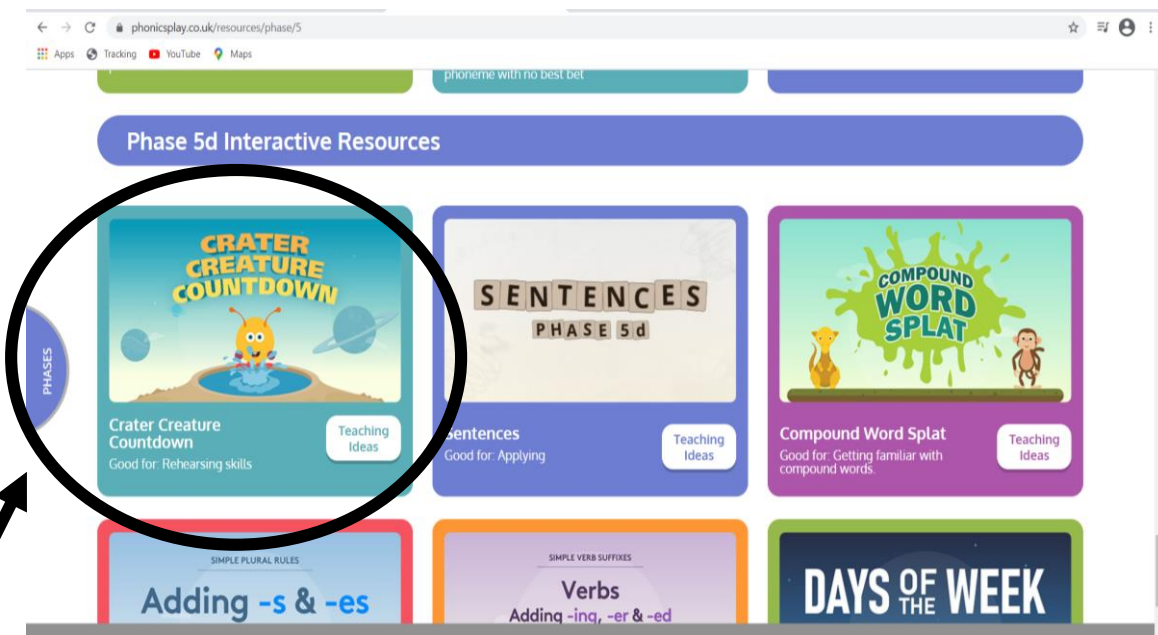

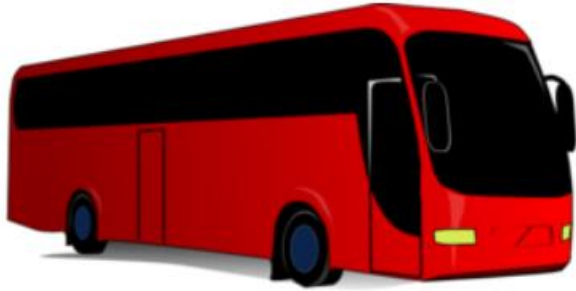
Do you remember the rules for plurals?
