## Order the seasons.

Can you research the four seasons, what are they called and how many are there? Can you order them?



Draw a tree in each of the seasons. What would it look like? How would it change?

## Create a weather diary!



Can you keep a diary of the weather every day for a week by drawing a picture of the weather you see?

Perhaps you can use your phonics knowledge to write some words or a sentence.

## Sun safety...

Draw a picture of someone who is going outside in very hot weather. How can they protect themselves from the sun?



## Winter warmth...

Draw a picture of someone who is going outside in very cold weather. How can they keep themselves warm?



## Outside adjectives.

Go and have a look outside. What is the weather like today? Think of as many describing words as you can to describe what the weather is like.
