Today, we will write about the final Plot Point- Plot Point 4.


## Plot Point 4

The Tear Thief collected tears from all different households for many different reasons. The Tear Thief heard a girl crying under a lamppost and went to see.


You will continue to write your diary entry today. You will write at least 3 sentences, so at the end of today's lesson, you will have written at least 10 sentences altogether. 

Your first sentence will be about collecting the tears from another one of the children in the town. You can use your  imagination to explain why they were crying.

Your second sentence will be to describe what you  see when you look into your sack full of jewel tears.

Your third sentence will be to explain how you feel when you  hear the girl crying under the lamppost.

After this, you can edit your work. Look at the features of a diary, on the following page to help you check you have not missed anything!

Deepen the moment- you might add a  metaphor to describe the tears in the sack. Remember, a metaphor is when you describe something directly as something else:  
*The tears were fireworks lighting up the dark.*
