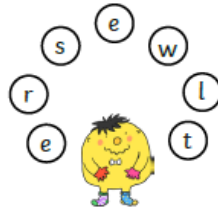
Mr Whoops' Juggling Muddle!

Clumsy Mr. Whoops has been juggling with this week's wr words and he's got in a real juggling muddle! Can you help him to unjumble each word using the clues to help?

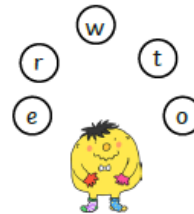
